

## Red

Hugo Casanova Reserva Merlot, Maule Valley, 13%, 2019, Chile.

This reserva is aged 10 months in French oak barrels which give a chocolate, tobacco and spice note on the nose, while the taste is mature and complex with a long finish.

Lupo Nero Rosso, IGP Pulia, 12.5% 2021, Italy. (Primitivo, Negroamaro blend)
Hailing from the deep south of Italy, this wine offers generous quantities of dark berry fruit with a ripeness that only the warmth of Mediterranean sun can bring.

Santa Florentina, Malbec, Tierra del Oro, 13%, 2021, Argentina. Smooth and fruity, medium bodied wine with soft fruity aromas and flavours, accompanied by smooth tannins and a lingering finish. An excellent example of Argentinian Malbec.

## Rosé

Pinot Grigio Rosato, IGP Di Pavia, 12%, 2022, Italy.

A fantastic, easy drinking Pinot Grigio Rosato with a delicate pink colour and a light, floral aroma. It has a supple and fresh taste. Pairs well with salads and white meats.

## White

Soldier Farm, Chardonnay, 13%, 2021, South Eastern Australia. This Chardonnay is light yet creamy with tropical flavours of peach, pineapple and citrus, leading to a long and satisfying finish.

Lupo Nero Bianco, IGP Terre Siciliane, 12%, 2022, Italy. (Garganega, Pinot Grigio, Chardonnay Blend) Very pale gold colour with a subtle honeyed nose. Gorgeous quince, and tropical fruit. Crisp, lovely length.

Armonia, Sauvignon Blanc, Maule Valley, 12%, 2022, Chile. Armonia translates from Italian to 'harmony' which perfectly describes this white that has a delicate fruity nose, and rounded gooseberry fruit.
